





US CONGRESS DISTRICT 20

























SHOULD THE HOURS FOR MIDDLE SCHOOL BE EARLIER, AND ELEMENTARY BE LATER?



SHOULD MIDDLE SCHOOL STUDENTS BE ALLOWED TO USE VENDING MACHINES DURING SCHOOL HOURS?



SHOULD EACH SCHOOL GET THE SAME AMOUNT OF SCHOOL SUPPLIES?








